Warrenville Youth & Family Services (WYFS), a multi-purpose community service agency serving the greater Warrenville area, empowers residents through holistic programming to become all that God intends them to be. WYFS provides services to all and, where fees apply, bases them on ability to pay.

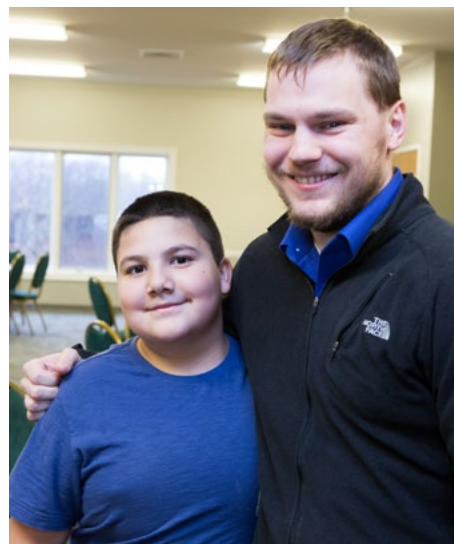
WYFS PROGRAMS

Quest after-school and summer programs provided a structured and safe environment for 77 junior high and early senior high youth in FY15. Quest activities include academic coaching, life skills training, recreation and participation in community service projects.

Link Mentoring matched 27 young people with caring adult volunteers in FY15. Mentors and youth develop friendships through shared activities as mentors offer guidance, support and encouragement.

Counseling is provided at WYFS through Outreach Community Counseling Centers. Staff therapists professionally trained in the latest research use practices demonstrated to work in addressing a wide variety of concerns. Last year, our therapists served 171 people through individual, couples and family counseling.

Case Management services at WYFS provided financial and referral assistance to 235 individuals with pressing financial needs in the Warrenville area last year. WYFS manages the distribution of Warrenville Partners in Ministry's Local Emergency Assistance Funds as well as funds from The Salvation Army and the Illinois Department of Human Services.





"A mentoring relationship has been proven through countless research studies to be an effective form of prevention in destructive behaviors in a young person's life," says Leslee Ferguson, coordinator for the Academic Coaching and Link Mentoring programs. "In the Link program I get to see that play out each week. Our mentors and mentees tend to be worlds apart in numerous ways; from their culture to their values, from their preferences to their priorities and experiences. But, for 90 minutes each week, all those differences vanish. I get to see what makes mentoring so powerful—mentors making their students feel connected, supported, heard and cared for."
