



Response to COVID-19

Outreach Community Ministries (OCM) is highly committed to our communities and we are taking immediate action to ensure our clients, clinicians, and staff can participate in a setting that is safe and consistent with federal and state guidelines to address the Coronavirus (COVID-19). As of Wednesday, March 18th all on-site, in-person client sessions were discontinued, however, **all three counseling centers remain open for therapists to provide care via telehealth platforms.**

Our three clinic locations, Outreach Community Counseling Center in Carol Stream, Warrenville Youth & Family Services, and Wheaton Youth Outreach will remain open during the government mandated "shelter-in-place" order. Our goal is to continue to provide essential, mental health outpatient treatment to those under our care. Given the expanded coverage of telehealth services, each of our locations are able to provide outpatient therapy services via HIPAA-compliant, secure telehealth platforms, as well as telephonic sessions. When scheduling with your therapist, he or she will discuss with you the current options and give you more information about how to proceed.

Our clinics will continue to accept new patients during this time, so please call the location nearest to your home to access our services. A member of our clinical team will return your call within 24-48 hours as we check our general, inbox voicemails regularly.
